

As Summer Winds Down, Keep Your Skin Healthy

Hydroquinone, Kojic Acid, Lactic Acid, Azelaic Acid, Niacinamide → Custom blends can help fade dark spots and mild to moderate discoloration.

Tacrolimus / Pimecrolimus → Long-term eczema control without steroids.

Fighting infections:

Ketoconazole, Miconazole, Nystatin → Treat fungal rashes and athlete's foot.

Managing acne and rosacea:

Sodium Sulfacetamide & Sulfur → Reduce bumps, redness, and irritation.

Relieving discomfort:

Lidocaine / Pramoxine → Soothe itching, stinging, or sunburn pain.

Aloe Vera & Menthol → Provide cooling, soothing relief.

Restoring skin's barrier:

Ceramides → Rebuild and lock in moisture for dry, sensitive skin.

After months of sun, many people look for ways to reduce signs of aging and protect their skin for the future. Compounded treatments can include:

- Tretinoin Encourages new cell growth, smooths fine lines, evens tone
- Niacinamide Improves elasticity and reduces redness
- Vitamin C Brightens skin and protects against free radical damage
- Alpha-Lipoic Acid Improves texture and reduces stress on skin
- Peptides Boost collagen and firmness
- Hyaluronic Acid Deep hydration for plump, smooth skin
